NEW SOD WATERING

Day 1 to 4, water twice a day
 Day 5 to 14, water once a day
 Week 3, water once every 2 to 3 days
 Week 4, water once every 3 to 7 days

Sprinkler Head Run Times
 -Run spray heads, 5 to 7 minutes
 -Run rotors heads, 10 to 15 minutes
 -Run high-efficiency rotary nozzles 15 to 20 minutes

WATERING

Water every 3 to 7 days. Sprinkler head run times above are a good starting point. Use the supplemental irrigation chart to adjust for each month. Example, June's irrigation requirement is 2.25". Divide by 4 and you need to apply .56" water per week. Water twice a week and apply .28" of water each run time.

FIRST MOWING

Mow at 1" after 7 to 10 days when dry. This will even out the grass. Don't worry if you scalp. It will grow back quickly and more uniform.

MOWING

Mow every 7 to 14 days at 2" for a traditional yard. Mow more frequently if shorter. Mow less or not at all for a natural look. Mow 1/2" to 4".

FERTILIZATION

Fertilize 3 times a year in May, July and August. Apply 1 lbs of nitrogen per application. Use organic fertilizer any time.

AERATION & THATCHING

Aerate once a year to reduce compaction in the summer. De-thatch any time grass is growing. This will reduce density and even out the height.

WATER REQUIREMENTS

10" to 12" supplemental Irrigation per year

April	.5"
May	1"
June	2.25"
July	2.25"
August	2.25"
September	2"
October	1"
Total	11.25"

SPRING WAKE UP

In April, mow, power rake, verticut or any combo to open up the grass and increase the ground temperature. This will help with spring green up.

TURF DYE AND PIGMENT

Spray on green turf dye or turf pigment any time grass is dormant or straw color for a green appearance. This will help warm up the grass in spring, March, or April and extend color into late fall and winter.

DORMANCY

When Tahoma 31 is dormant or straw-colored, relax and let it go. It does not need any water, fertilizer or care. It also handles traffic all winter long.
